

- who are Singapore citizens must sing the National Anthem and take the Pledge. Students will take the Pledge with the right fist placed over the heart




For Girls

- Only small ear studs not more than 0.5 cm in diameter can be worn
- No hair dye or tint of any kind is allowed
- No make-up of any kind is allowed
- Branded articles/jewellery should not be worn to school
- Fingernails must be kept short and neat. No nail polish is allowed
- Chains or strings worn around the neck must be long enough to be hidden under the blouse or shirt


For Boys

- Male students must be neat in appearance, clean-shaven and no facial hair is allowed
- Hair should be neatly cropped and combed. The back of the hair should be cut sloped
- Fringe must not cover eyebrows
- No hair dye or tint of any kind is allowed


